A new nursery term has begun. It has been lovely to welcome all your children back to the nursery for the start of the new term! Your children have been fantastic and have settled back in great.



Safe Routes to Nursery

All children have the right to a safe route to nursery. Sadly, children's safety can often be compromised by drivers attitudes to parking in the Campus and streets surrounding the Campus.

If driving to nursery, please do not park in zigzag lines or in a way which may endanger others.

Arrival / Collection

Before entering and leaving the nursery playroom please make sure your encouraging signing in and out. When your child is being brought and collected to and from nursery, please come into the playroom with your child so a member of staff knows that your child is in for their session DO NOT HOLD THE DOOR OPEN! Can we please ask that only one member of family enters the nursery to keep the traffic to a minimum! Toys from home are not permitted in the nursery playrooms as this is an upset to all children, we have plenty of resource in the nursery playrooms for all children. Food and snacks are also not to be brought into nursery we would be grateful if children are having something to eat before their session please wait outside until this is finished before entering the nursery, there is children in the nursery with allergies.

Annual Data Checks

Each year we collect vital information about your contact details and emergency contact details.

It is essential that all your child's details are accurate and up to date in their nursery record.

Your child will also bring home important consent forms which must be returned to the nursery office as soon as possible.

Toy Fund

Please remember to pay the £2 contribution per week. Toy Fund is an important part of nursery life as it helps us to buy resources and special treats for the children, all children benefit from these donations. Every penny donated is spent on the children

Children's bags

Bags are supplied by the nursery to be kept in the nursery please do not bring bags from home as we don't not have the space. Children require some spare change of clothes for various reasons, toileting accidents, outdoors etc. The nursery does not keep a supply of clothes. Please ensure you check your child's bags daily to ensure they have spares, otherwise we will need to phone emergency contacts to bring a change of clothes if required. Can you please label all clothing and footwear with your child's name please. For children that are in nappies staff will advise when these are running low for these to be topped out. Please do not leave medication in bags please advise Management of any medication that is required.

Timekeeping, attendance and absence

In the past we have seen children being brought to nursery a lot earlier before their sessions begin. If you are early for your session unfortunately, you will not be given access into the building until your child session begins. If your child attends an AM session, please note entry will close at 10:00AM, and late arrivals will not be admitted and will be asked to attend at their next session and if a PM session entry will close at 2:00PM. Parents and carers should inform the nursery staff if their child is likely to be absent. If your child has an appointment within nursery hours, please advise a member of staff of this. We understand lateness can occur but please if you're going to be late at any point again, contact the office on 0141 947 4740 or headteacher@benview-nursery.glasgow.sch.uk
